

Highlights

Tsinghua SEM's first undergrad summer internship practice program begins

Tsinghua SEM's inaugural undergraduate summer internship and practice program has commenced in 2022. The summer program is one of the important methods for talent development in Tsinghua SEM. It serves as a rich and diverse teaching approach that deeply integrates academia, industry, and research. It also represents the implementation of a distinctive undergraduate program offered by Tsinghua SEM. Throughout the summer program, enterprises and the school worked together to enhance students' abilities in solving practical problems, leadership skills, and teamwork through immersive, experiential, and interactive learning modes.

Statue of Professor ZHAO Jiahe unveiled

An unveiling ceremony for the statue of Professor ZHAO Jiahe was held on September 9, 2022. The year marks the tenth anniversary of ZHAO's passing, as well as the establishment of the Gansu Xinghua Youth Aid Foundation, which he founded a decade ago. To commemorate and uphold Professor ZHAO Jiahe's devoted spirit, Tsinghua University School of Economics and Management (Tsinghua SEM) erected a statue in his honor at the Lihua Building. Additionally, in collaboration with the Tsinghua History Museum, Tsinghua SEM organized an exhibition titled "Passing on the Torch: The Era Needs ZHAO Jiahe".

Tsinghua SEM approved for multiple 2022 NSFC programs

The National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC) announced an evaluation and approval results for the applied programs for the year 2022 in a centralized submission in September 2022. Tsinghua SEM received a total of 14 approved programs, including one program under the National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars, two under the National Excellent Young Scientists Fund, one key program, five general programs, and five programs under the Young Scientists Fund.

Tsinghua Xuetang Economics Program begins

The launch ceremony for the Tsinghua Xuetang Economics Program was held on September 9, 2022. The program aims to cultivate exceptional academic leaders in economics who possess expertise in modern economic analysis methods and the ability to generate original ideas. These individuals are expected to have a global vision while understanding the unique national conditions and characteristics of China. By integrating China's distinctive economic practices with general economic laws, the program seeks to promote the development and advancement of the discipline, as well as enhance the international influence and explanatory power of Chinese economics.

Faculty and students at Tsinghua SEM study and implement spirit of the 20th CPC National Congress

Following the conclusion of the 20th National Congress of the Communist Party of China (CPC), Tsinghua SEM, in accordance with the arrangements made by the Party Committee of Tsinghua University, organized activities to study and implement the spirit of the congress. These activities included learning sessions conducted by the theoretical center group, seminars for Party members and administrative leaders, school-wide study and report meetings, exchange meetings for faculty and student Party members, as well as joint organizational activities. From April to August 2022, the school conducted themed education to study and implement XI Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era.

Tsinghua SEM wins MA Yuehan Cup championships in men's, women's basketball and women's soccer

The MA Yuehan Cup men's and women's 5 vs. 5 basketball finals were held on November 17, 2022. Tsinghua SEM's men's and women's basketball teams both won the championship, breaking a 16-year dormancy for the men's team and setting a legendary record of four championships in five years for the women's team.

On April 15, 2023, in the MA Yuehan Cup women's soccer match, the school's women's soccer team won the overall championship of the university, marking their fourth championship trophy in the past six women's soccer seasons.

BAI Chong-En elected president of AAPBS

The Annual Meeting 2022 of the Association of Asia-Pacific Business Schools (AAPBS) was held on November 21, 2022. During the meeting, BAI was elected as the new president of the AAPBS. Through this meeting, the school further strengthened communication and exchange with leading business schools in the Asia-Pacific region, promoted collaboration and development among institutions, and consolidated the school's influence in the Asia-Pacific region. In the future, the school will continue to maintain close communication with member institutions and discuss cooperative development in areas such as student training and faculty exchange.

Research Center for Digital Economy (Greater Bay Area) and Expert Advisory Board at Tsinghua University Shenzhen Institute of Economics and Management established

The Research Center for Digital Economy (Greater Bay Area) at Tsinghua University Shenzhen Institute of Economics and Management was established on November 25, 2022. Professor FENG Juan, the Hon Hai chair professor and deputy head of the Department of Management Science and Engineering at Tsinghua University, as well as a professor at the Institute of Innovation Management of Tsinghua Shenzhen International Graduate School, was appointed director of the research center. The Expert Advisory Board of the research center formed the same day. The board consists of professors from Tsinghua University and representatives from leading digital ecosystem entities who serve as advisors. Its purpose is to conduct in-depth research and support industry-academia collaboration in areas such as digital economy and data assets, enterprise digital transformation and management, and business big data analysis.

2022 Annual Meeting of Tsinghua SEM AdvisoryBoard held

The 2022 Annual Meeting of the Tsinghua SEM Advisory Board was held at the Diaoyutai State Guesthouse on December 8, 2022 in Beijing. This marked the 23rd annual meeting since the establishment of the advisory board. The meeting was conducted in a hybrid format, combining both online and offline participation, with a total of 36 board members attending, including 29 overseas members. On December 9, Chinese Vice President WANG Qishan met with the overseas members of the Advisory Board and Chinese entrepreneur members via video conference in Beijing.

Hualong Dianjing Joint Team awarded first prize in the comprehensive category for its 2022 Tsinghua University Graduate 'December 9 Movement' Theme Education Event

The 2022 Tsinghua University Graduate "December 9 Movement" Theme Education activities concluded on December 21, 2022. The Hualong Dianjing Joint Team, consisting of students from Tsinghua SEM and the Department of Chemical Engineering, performed exceptionally well in the themed educational event and was awarded the highest honor - the Comprehensive First Prize. This achievement marks the team's fifth consecutive year receiving this prestigious award.

Professor XU Xin receives AIS Fellow Award

Professor XU Xin, the CV Starr Chair Professor and associate dean of Tsinghua SEM, was honored with the AIS Fellow Award on December 12, 2022, at the International Association for Information Systems (AIS) Annual Meeting in Copenhagen, Denmark. AIS is the most authoritative academic group in the field of information systems, with more than 5,000 members around the world. The AIS Fellow Award recognizes scholars who have made outstanding contributions and demonstrated influence in research, education, and service in the international information systems field.

Tsinghua SEM hosts 2023 Advisory Board Spring Event

Tsinghua SEM hosted the 2023 Advisory Board Spring Event on March 28, 2023 in Beijing. The event was attended by members of the advisory board who were participating in the China Development Forum 2023. During the morning session, Chinese Vice President HAN Zheng and representatives from the advisory board engaged in discussions. Tim Cook, chairman of the advisory board and CEO of Apple, introduced their educational exchanges and cooperation in talent training in China. Following the talks, a roundtable meeting of the advisory board was held, presided over by Tim Cook. Representatives and guests attending the event discussed the topic of "China and the World Economy: 2023 and Beyond."

Tsinghua Industrial Innovation MBA Program launched

Tsinghua SEM introduced the new Tsinghua Industrial Innovation MBA Program in March 2023. This program emphasizes the integration of industry and education, focusing on cultivating innovative talents who are proficient in cuttingedge technologies, have a deep understanding of future industry trends, possess an innovative thinking mindset, and master organizational and management skills. Professor ZHU Hengyuan from the Department of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Strategy serves as the academic director of the program.

Nine Tsinghua SEM professors make list of HighlyCited Chinese Researchers

Elsevier released its 2022 "Highly Cited Chinese Researchers" list on March 28, 2023. In total, nine professors from Tsinghua SEM were selected. BAI Chong-En, the Mansfield Freeman Chair Professor, a professor in the Department of Economics, and the Dean of Tsinghua SEM, were included in the Applied Economics category. Associate Professor Steven White from the Department of Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Strategy was listed in the Business Management category. CHEN Jian, the Lenovo Chair Professor from the Department of Management Science and Engineering, and CHEN Jin, the Apple Chair Professor from the Department of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Strategy, were selected in the Management Science and Engineering category. In the Business Management category, three professors were recognized: CHEN Yubo, the Coca-Cola Chair Professor from the Department of Marketing, LI Ning, the Flextronics Chair Professor from the Department of Leadership and Organization Management, and LI Xibao, an associate professor in the Department of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Strategy, were selected in the field of Business Management, QIAN Yingvi, the Distinguished Professor of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences at Tsinghua University and a professor from the Department of Economics, and SU Liangjun, the CV Starr Chair Professor and a professor from the Department of Economics, were included in the Theoretical Economics category.

Dean-Alumni face-to-face event and unveiling ceremony for Tsinghua SEM alumni donation wall

In celebration of Tsinghua University's 112th anniversary and the 39th anniversary of Tsinghua SEM, the Dean-Alumni Face-to-Face event was held on April 29, 2023. Dean BAI Chong-En shared the latest developments of the school and discussed future development plans. More than 300 alumni attended the event. As part of the event, there was an unveiling ceremony for the alumni donation wall, where teacher representatives, alumni representatives, and relevant department heads jointly unveiled the donation wall.

70th anniversary of Tsinghua University's 'Dual-Responsibility' political counselor system, Alumni-Junior Dialogue on Future Paths Event is held

The traditional alumni event "Embarking on Life - Alumni-Junior Dialogue on Future Paths" was held on April 29, 2023. That date also marked the 70th anniversary of the establishment of Tsinghua University's "Dual-Responsibility" political counselor system. Five alumni who previously served as political counselors — PAN Qingzhong (Class of 1984), YANG Nuo (Class of 2011), QI Jing (Class of 2011), NI Xiaoran (Class of 2012), and LIU Chang (Class of 2013) — attended the event and spoke with junior students.

Three Tsinghua SEM courses named national first-class among undergrads

The Ministry of Education released its list of nationally recognized first-class undergraduate courses in the second batch on April 11, 2023. Tsinghua SEM had three courses selected: "Principles of Economics (1)" (course coordinator: QIAN Yingyi) and "Principles of Accounting" (course coordinator: XUE Jian) were recognized as first-class offline courses, and "Blockchain and Cryptocurrency" (course coordinator: LUO Mei) was recognized as a first-class online course.

Tsinghua University President's Innovation Challenge celebrates 10th anniversary with science and education symposium

The Tsinghua University President's Innovation Challenge celebrated its 10th anniversary with a science and education symposium sponsored by Tsinghua SEM and the Department of Electronic Engineering on the morning of April 30, 2023. The symposium, organized by Tsinghua x-lab and the Institute for Electronics and Information Technology in Tianjin, Tsinghua University, focused on the strengths of Tsinghua SEM and the Department of Electronic Engineering in the fields of commercialization and hard technology. Its aim was to promote the "Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Creativity" education philosophy and the commercialization of scientific and technological achievements at Tsinghua University. By deeply implementing strategies that prioritize the development of science, technology and education, talent empowerment, and innovation-driven growth, the university can achieve the goals of advancing education-first development, fostering self-reliance in science and technology, and having driving forces led by talent.

Tsinghua SEM undergrads achieve good results in2023 HSBC Chinese Mainland Business Competition

Tsinghua University's undergraduate students SONG Liudi, CHEN Youran, ZHANG Shiying, and LIU Zhuoyu, under the guidance of Professor JIAO Jie from the Department of Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Strategy, formed the Tsinghua University team "The Honorable Unit" to participate in the 2023 HSBC Chinese Mainland Business Competition in May 2023. The competition took place online and featured representative teams from renowned domestic business schools. The Tsinghua University team achieved remarkable results by securing the preliminary championship of the north competition zone and the runner-up position in the national final of the HSBC competition.

The awards ceremony of the first Tsinghua SEMQihang Prize held

The awards ceremony of the first Tsinghua SEM Qihang Prize was held on June 21, 2023. The school places great emphasis on providing career guidance to students and encourages them to integrate their personal aspirations with the strategic needs of the nation. The students are expected to become academic leaders with lofty ambitions, capable talents for industry development, and pillars for national governance. In order to commend outstanding graduates who have made impactful career choices, the prize were presented to 10 students (HE Yunwen, LI Liyuan, LIU Yutong, LIU Zixu, MU Changcheng, SUN Yushan, WANG Deqi, WU Yunzhi, ZHANG Chenyu and ZHOU Tianwu). They will work in key enterprises, key regions, or renowned universities at home and abroad.

Tsinghua SEM holds 2023 graduation ceremony

The 2023 Tsinghua SEM graduation ceremony was held on June 25, 2023. The ceremony was presided over by Dean BAI Chong-En. Dr. Ya-Qin ZHANG, a chair professor at Tsinghua University, dean of the Institute for AI Industry Research (AIR) at Tsinghua University, an academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering, and a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, delivered the commencement speech. During the 2022-2023 academic year, a total of 1,615 students graduated from the school. They include 248 undergraduate students, 52 secondary degree undergraduate students, 106 undergraduate students pursuing a minor degree, 1,156 graduate students (including MBA and EMBA), and 53 doctoral students.

Undergraduate Programs

Our undergraduate education adopted a triangular education model that incorporates value shaping, ability cultivation, and knowledge obtainment. Meanwhile, with virtue being the foundation a person, we've always placed "value shaping" at our top priority. Facing new challenges, we constantly refine our undergraduate program to better train "cross-lateral innovative economics and management bachelors with global competence", and in 2021, we won the second price of the Beijing Teaching Achievement in High Education. In recent years, we continue to strengthen our general education curriculum. In 2019, we added "Intelligent Computation and Data Science" as a new mandatory course. In 2021, we further improved our general education curriculum, and established five core-skill-course groups including: understanding civilizations; exploring society; scientific thinking; debating, communication and leadership; and aesthetic and innovation. In 2020, we welcomed our first cohort of students

in the dual undergraduate degree program in Computer Science and Finance. In 2021, Tsinghua-CUHK Dual Undergraduate Degree Programme in Economics started admission progress. In 2022, we established and started to enroll new students for Tsinghua Xuetang Economics Program together with Tsinghua University's School of Social Sciences.





Doctoral Programs

The PhD programs utilize our multi-subject advantage to train researchers in economics and management for top universities, public sectors, and academic institutions. We emphasize on improving doctoral students' education quality through establishing a well-rounded teaching system, and pounding our education objective into each and every education process. In 2022, 60% of our graduate choose an academic career path and work in the regions of strategical development goals, or renowned universities in China (including Central University of Finance and Economics, Shandong

University, China University of Petroleum, Shanghai International Studies University, and Southwestern University of Finance and Economics). Besides an academic career, many of our graduates also joined the Chinese central government agencies and local governments, including China's Ministry of Finance, the General Office of Jilin Province, and etc. Meanwhile, in 2022, SHENG Dalin (PhD in Economics, Class of 2016, currently teaching in SWUFE), and WEI Chuang, (PhD in Marketing, Class of 2017, currently teaching in CUFE) were awarded with the Bronze Prize of "Tsinghua University Graduates Qihang Award".



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Master's Programs

The Master's programs cultivate the most talented domestic and international students, continuously increase influence and promote internationalization. The exam-free recommendation ratio for full-time Master's programs is over 10:1, and the enrollment ratio for the national examination rises to 19.5:1. With the applicants of 2022 coming from 55 countries and regions, the programs have sustained a year-by-year increase in international applications as well as application-to-enrollment rate. The quality of students admitted to Tsinghua MCFO Master's Program of Accounting has also been steadily improved.

During the academic year 2022-2023, the master's programs have achieved fruitful results. As for talent cultivation, the cooperation with the school's Advisory Board members has deepened. Master in Management (MiM) program collaborated with McKinsey in Business Projects for the fifth consecutive year, and with Siemens for the third year. Tsinghua-Columbia Dual Master's Degree Program in Business Analytics (TCMiBA) has enhanced its cooperation with Lingban Aiaas, Zhong'an Insurance, Kuaishou Group, DiDi Global Inc. and Bairong. Inc., and Tsinghua MCFO Master's Program of Accounting has recruited 13 industry tutors to teach students in top companies. Facing COVID-19 pandemic, Master's programs have adjusted and optimized the academic schedules in collaboration with international partners, continuously improving their global influence. In the Masters in Management Rankings 2022 by Financial Times, Tsinghua SEM ranked No. 11 in the world and No. 1 in Asia. Master of Finance program of Tsinghua SEM ranks No. 5 in the world and No.1 in Asia in the Financial Times 2023 Global Masters in Finance (pre-experience) rankings.






Tsinghua-Columbia Dual Master's Degree Program in Business Analytics

Noteworthy examples include the Executive Management Training Program for Central State-owned Enterprise Leaders (EMT), entrusted by the Organization Department of the CPC Central Committee and the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council, the New Era Entrepreneurs Development Program (NEED), entrusted by the United Front Work Department of the CPC Central Committee and the All-China Federation of Industry and Commerce, and the Business and Management Training Program for Leaders of Beijing Municipal Enterprises, entrusted by the Organization Department of the Beijing Municipal CPC Committee. These programs have been crucial in fostering leadership skills and driving success among participants.

In relentless pursuit of online continuing education, the center has introduced the Tsinghua SEM Professional Management Program. This specialized program leverages resources from Tsinghua SEM and has already garnered remarkable success with two cohorts under its belt. The program has earned it the first prize for Outstanding Programs of Tsinghua Continuing Education in 2022.

Fostering interdisciplinary collaborations, the Center has joined forces with the School of Software and Tsinghua Law School to launch the pioneering Chief Digital Officer Program (CDO). As the first program of its kind in China, it equips technology executives with the skills needed to navigate the ever-evolving digital landscape.

In May 2023, Tsinghua SEM orchestrated the second installment of the Eco-Explorer program in Beijing, reinforcing its commitment to collaborating with various departments of Tsinghua University.

This effort aims to create an advanced platform for exploring the integration of industry, academia, research, and application. By bringing together visionary and patriotic business leaders with entrepreneurial spirit, the program strives to promote pivotal breakthroughs and applications in key carbon technologies.

Recognizing the significance of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area's development, the center has successfully executed several programs in Shenzhen. These initiatives have garnered high acclaim from both participants and local partners.

Furthermore, the center has proudly concluded the inaugural cohort of the Global Executive Program in China (GEPC). With its global reach and courses taught in English, this program represents its commitment to innovating in the realm of global education models.

In addition, the center has been actively forging enduring strategic partnerships with esteemed international institutions of higher learning, ensuring that China's voice resonates on the global stage.

Moreover, drawing on its extensive expertise in custom programs, the center remains steadfast in its mission to empower enterprises—both domestic and international, state-owned and private—by providing impetus for sustainable growth and serving as a visionary think tank for pioneering development. With a keen focus on aligning with the unique management practices and organizational nuances of each enterprise, the custom programs deliver tailored solutions and curated resource blends for effective organizational learning. By seamlessly integrating executive education with an international and interdisciplinary knowledge-sharing platform, the Center fosters an environment primed for perpetual innovation, prosperity, and mutually beneficial collaborations.

Tsinghua x-lab

attention to the society, identify problems and come up with great ideas, with 37 freshmen teams signing up and demonstrating their creativity on the university stage. Focusing on the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, the final session of third "SDG Open Hack @ Tsinghua University" was successfully held on December 25, 2022. During the competition, over 150 solutions were proposed by more than 900 innovators in the hope of achieving the sustainable development goals.

The 7th TIE² Tsinghua TUM International Innovation
Entrepreneurship Exchange was successfully held online from
November 7 to 11, 2022, with the theme of "Deep Tech". Eight
Tsinghua start-up teams with the intention of expanding their
projects to the international market were selected to participate
in this program. Featuring online lectures, workshops, mentoring
and networking sessions, the program sought to broaden the
students' international vision and enhance their innovation skills.

On February 24, 2023, the "Shenzhen Innovation and Technology Forum and Tsinghua University's 10th President's Cup Innovation Challenge Shenzhen Launch Ceremony" was held in Shenzhen, organized by Tsinghua x-lab, Shenzhen Institute of Economics and Management, Tsinghua University, and co-hosted by the Shenzhen International Graduate School, Tsinghua University. The event received widespread attention from the society. Over 50 leaders and experts from various fields including government departments, universities, financial institutions, and venture capital companies gathered at the scene to start a knowledge feast on entrepreneurship and technological innovation. They jointly explored how to promote the interaction between entrepreneurship and economic development. The event attracted more than 2,500 people to participate online.

The 10th "Tsinghua University President's Innovation Challenge" kicked off on March 25, 2023 with the goal of developing and refining the entrepreneurial leadership skills of Tsinghua students. The competition attracted 127 Tsinghua start-up teams to participate in various sectors, including information technology, energy and environment, education, healthcare, hardware, manufacturing and so on.

Tsinghua SEM X-elerator

Tsinghua SEM X-elerator is an innovative service and value empowerment platform that inherits the spirit of Tsinghua University and focuses on serving entrepreneurs. With the goal of "gathering entrepreneurial talents and cultivating business leaders", X-elerator is creating a service system with a global perspective, and supporting Tsinghua University's scientific and technological achievements on transforming and implementing through the DNA Fund.




